Who we are

Connections is a voluntary program and referrals are based on parent consent. Connections works with Millard, Papillion-La Vista, Bellevue, and Omaha Public Schools to identify children, K-8th grade, in need of mental health services. We match children with community therapists who are trained in evidence-based practices and provide ongoing follow-up to families, referral sources and providers.

How we can help

We understand that this is a difficult time and many are struggling in the community. These uncertain and stressful times can weigh heavy on children and you may be concerned your child is dealing with mental health worries such as anxiety, depression, etc.

We are currently offering our services while utilizing social distancing and technology to keep you and your family safe while addressing your concerns.
