

GIFT AND BEQUEST

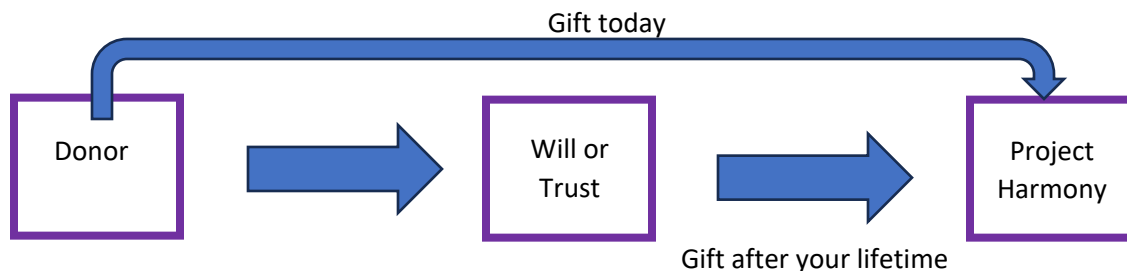
