Charitable Bequest

Include Project Harmony in your will or living trust. A simple statement can ensure your compassion continues to make a difference for years to come.

Gifts of Non-Cash Assets

You can make a gift of stocks, real estate or other appreciated assets to support Project Harmony while also receiving potential tax benefits.

Gifts of Financial Assets

Name Project Harmony as a beneficiary of your retirement plan, IRA, life insurance policy or other financial account. It's one of the easiest ways to create a meaningful legacy without revising your will.

Charitable Lead Trust

An irrevocable trust that provides income to Project Harmony for a set number of years, after which the remaining assets pass to you or another beneficiary. It offers tax benefits, including potential income, gift or estate tax reductions.

Charitable Remainder Trust

An irrevocable trust that provides income to you or another beneficiary for life or a set number of years, after which the remaining assets go to Project Harmony. It offers tax benefits, including potential income tax deductions and avoidance of immediate capital gains tax when appreciated assets are placed in the trust.
